

As per the directives of Government of India, the ‘Swachhta Pakhwada’ activities are being executed on priority basis by V.O. Chidambaranar Port Trust.

As per the scheduled Swachh Pakhwada Action Plan, today, on 20.03.2017, Color Washing and paintings of Residential Buildings and structures of Harbour Estate were carried out as per the colour code to ensure healthy environment. Signage boards and posters have also been placed areas of waste generation and handling. Action has also been taken to clean and repair the drainages systems available in the Port operational areas and Residential areas. In the wharf area cleaning works have been done in the berth VOC Wharf, Transit sheds and Warehouse – I.
