From the Desk of Chairperson



Shri Susanta Kumar Purohit, IRSEE Chairperson

I am delighted to welcome you to the third quarter newsletter for the financial year 2024-25. It is a privilege to share the significant milestones and progress our Port has achieved over the past months.

During the first three quarters of FY 2024-25, our Port handled 30.62 million tonnes of cargo, reflecting a 1.05% increase compared to 30.30 million tonnes during the same period last year. Our containerized cargo operations have demonstrated robust growth, with 5,81,557 TEUs handled, marking a 7% increase from the 5,43,531 TEUs achieved in the corresponding period of the previous financial year.

This growth has been further bolstered by the operationalization of our third Container Terminal, TICT. With its advanced infrastructure, including a 14.20-metre draft, 370-metre LOA, and an annual capacity of 6 lakh TEUs, TICT has significantly enhanced our capabilities.

I am proud to share that our Port continues to hold the Ist rank among major ports for Container Vessel Average Turnaround Time, achieving an impressive 19.92 hours up to December 2024. This distinction has been consistently maintained for three consecutive financial years—from 2022 to 2024—and continues into 2024-25. Additionally, our Operating Ratio of 27.87% up to December 2024 underscores our operational excellence and financial discipline.

Looking ahead, I am pleased to share that we will commission two Harbour Mobile Cranes with a capacity of 120 tonnes each within January 2024. Concurrently, dredging at North Cargo Berth-III to accommodate vessels with a 14.20-metre draft will enable interim operations to commence. The 240-metre-long Link Conveyor Project connecting Tamil Nadu Generation and Distribution Corporation Limited's conveyor with the Port's coal yard, along with the back-filling of North Cargo Berths II and III, are nearing completion. Furthermore, plans are underway to construct a multi-cargo Berth No. 10 with an LOA of 440 metres.

I extend my heartfelt gratitude to each of you for your dedication and contributions to our collective success. Together, we will continue to achieve new milestones and strengthen our position as the preferred port on India's east coast.

PORT PERFORMANCE

Traffic Performance

V.O.Chidambaranar Port handled 30.62 million tonnes of cargo up to the third quarter of this financial year 2024-25, as against 30.30 million tonnes handled during same period of the last year, registering an increase of 1.05 %.

The Port recorded a 7.00 % growth in container traffic, handling 5,81,557 TEUs up to the third quarter of the current financial year 2024-25, compared to 5,43,531 TEUs handled during the same period of the previous Financial Year.

Operational Achievements



On 29.10.2024, the Port achieved the Day's Highest cargo handled, by handling 2,04,512 tonnes, surpassing the previous volume of 2,04,051 tonnes handled on 23.02.2024.

Green Initiatives





The Port has generated 80,08,884 units of renewable energy up to December in the financial year 2024–25 through its 5 MW ground-based solar power plant, 2 MW wind turbine, and 640 kW rooftop solar power system. These efforts have led to substantial carbon savings of 65,67,285 kg of CO₂, highlighting the Port's commitment to green energy and environmental sustainability.
